YOUTH SPORTS

SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Effective immediately, the following spectator rules will be in effect at all Youth Sports programs:



Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or legal guardian when attending a Youth Sports program.



Parents and spectators are **not allowed** on the field of play.



Hats may be worn, but must be **straight forward**. Wearing hoodies or ski-masks are not allowed.



Cowbells, air horns, vuvuzela horns, whistles and devices that **simulate gunfire** are **not allowed** (canons, cap pistols, etc.).



The use of **obscene language**, cheers, or remarks is **prohibited**.

Anyone who enters the playing surface area and/or disrupts game play will be asked to leave the facility immediately.

SHOWCASE GUIDELINES

General Guidelines

- Routine is limited to **5 minutes**. Each team will be introduced by the event host.
- All **Coaches must check in participating squads by 11:15 a.m.**
- Dance, cheer and step routines must contain appropriate movements that are in good taste. No sexually explicit dancing will be tolerated.
- Routines must always promote good sportsmanship and respect for the opponents.
- Parents and coaches are responsible for the conduct of squads before, during, and after showcase activities.

Dress Code

- Jewelry of any kind is prohibited. (Except for if worn for medical/religious purpose and must be taped)
- Hair must be worn in a manner that is appropriate for the activity. Hair devices and accessories must be secure.
- Apparel and accessories must be appropriate for the activity involved.
 - ▷ Cheerleaders must wear athletic shoes.
 - ▷ When standing at attention, apparel must cover the midriff.
 - ▷ Must wear lollies/shorts/leggings under skirt
 - ▷ No halter tops.
 - ▷ All cheerleaders must dress in team uniform attire.

Music

All included music must be an edited, clean version with no bleeps or explicit language.

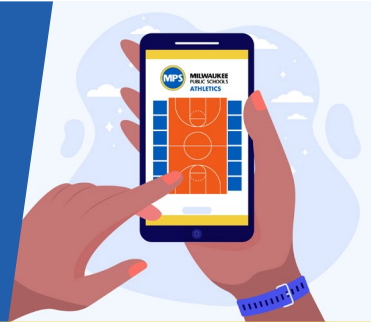
Stunts

- Non-release stunts/lifts
 - ▷ All partner stunts and pyramids are limited to two levels high, meaning that the top person(s) receive(s) primary support by one or more bases who is/are in direct, weight bearing contact with the performing surface.
 - ▷ There must be one spotter for every three girls
- Release stunts/tosses are not permitted.

Tumbling

- Tumbling or rebounding over or under a stunt, person or prop is not permitted except for non-airborne tumbling over a person or prop on the performing surface.
- Airborne twisting tumbling skills are not permitted, except for round-offs, cartwheels, and aerial cartwheels.

MILWAUKEE RECREATION YOUTH SPORTS ONLINE TICKETING SYSTEM



Digital tickets are required for all MPS Athletics stadium events. We made it easy for you to use our new online ticketing system to secure your ticket.

Tickets are available on a first come, first served basis. Admission will follow district limits, if any, for seating capacity (once tickets are sold out, the system will not offer tickets).

All stadium tickets are general admission. Tickets that require paid entry will be \$5. Unless otherwise stated, some events are free admission for all, but will still require a ticket for entry. Ages 65+ and youth 6 and under will be admitted for free (except for special events).

Please note: Masks and physical distancing will continue to be enforced at indoor events until further notice.

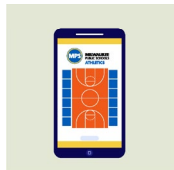
How to secure your event ticket online:
